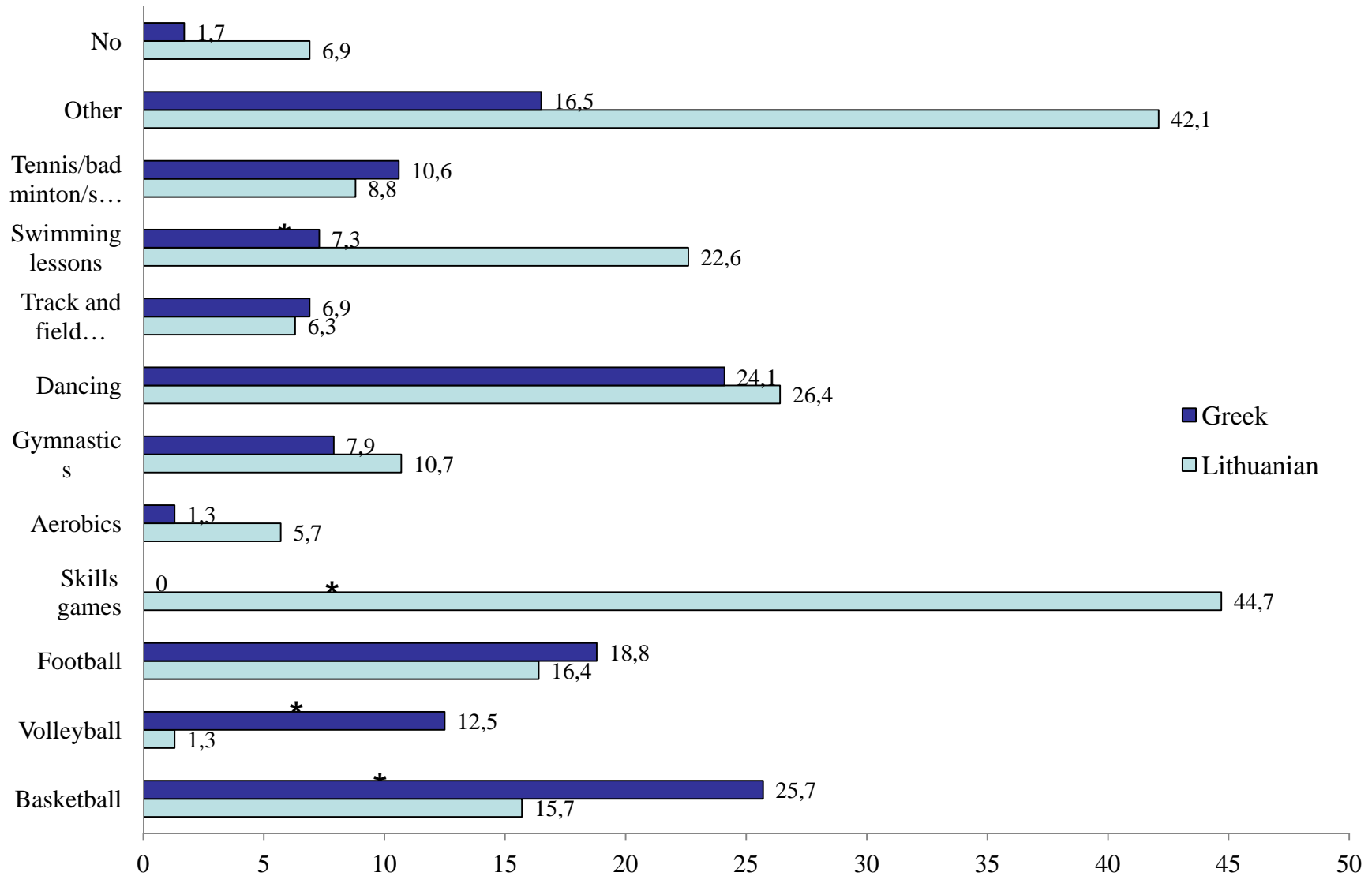

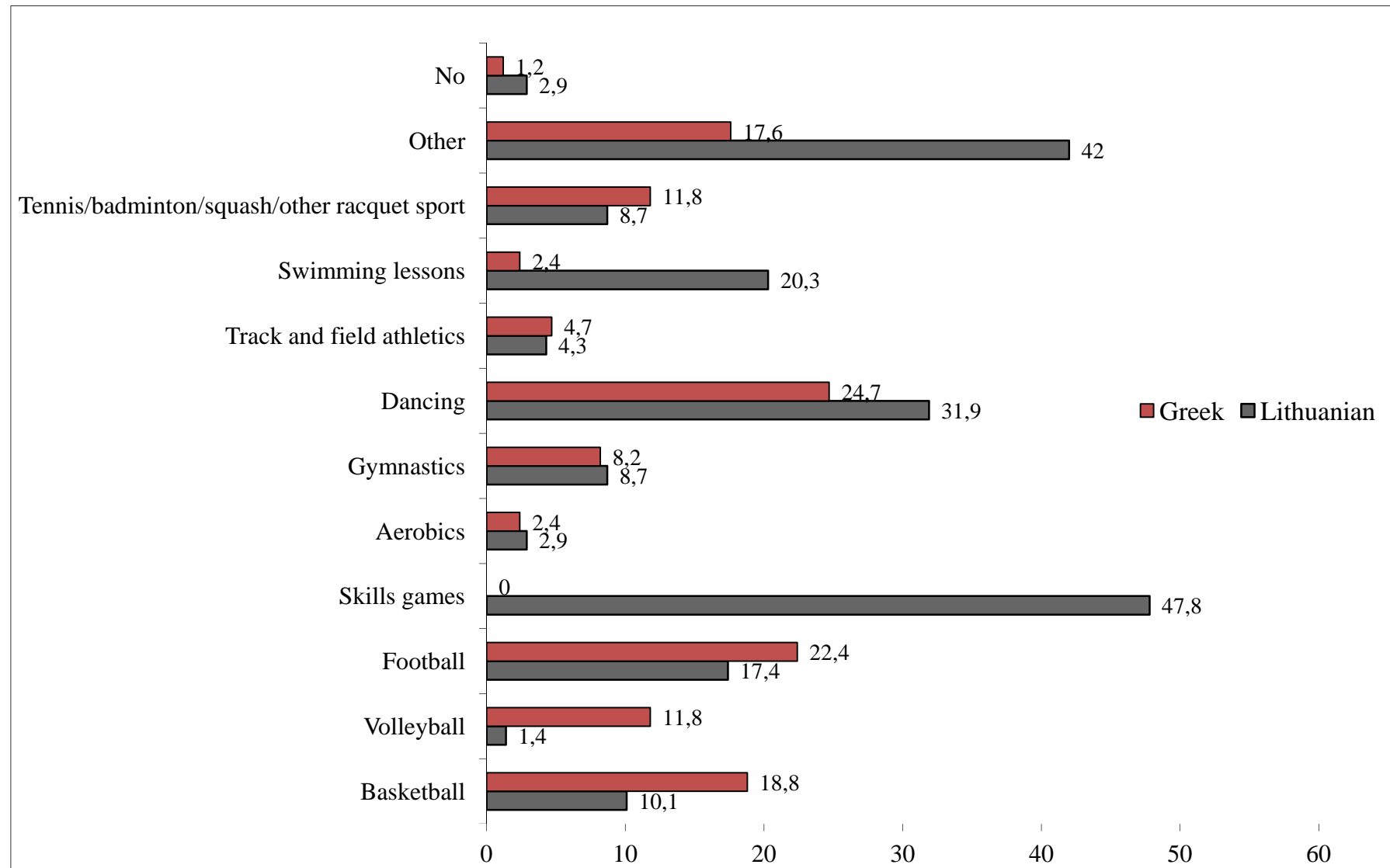

Organized physical activities of children in the past 7 days (%)



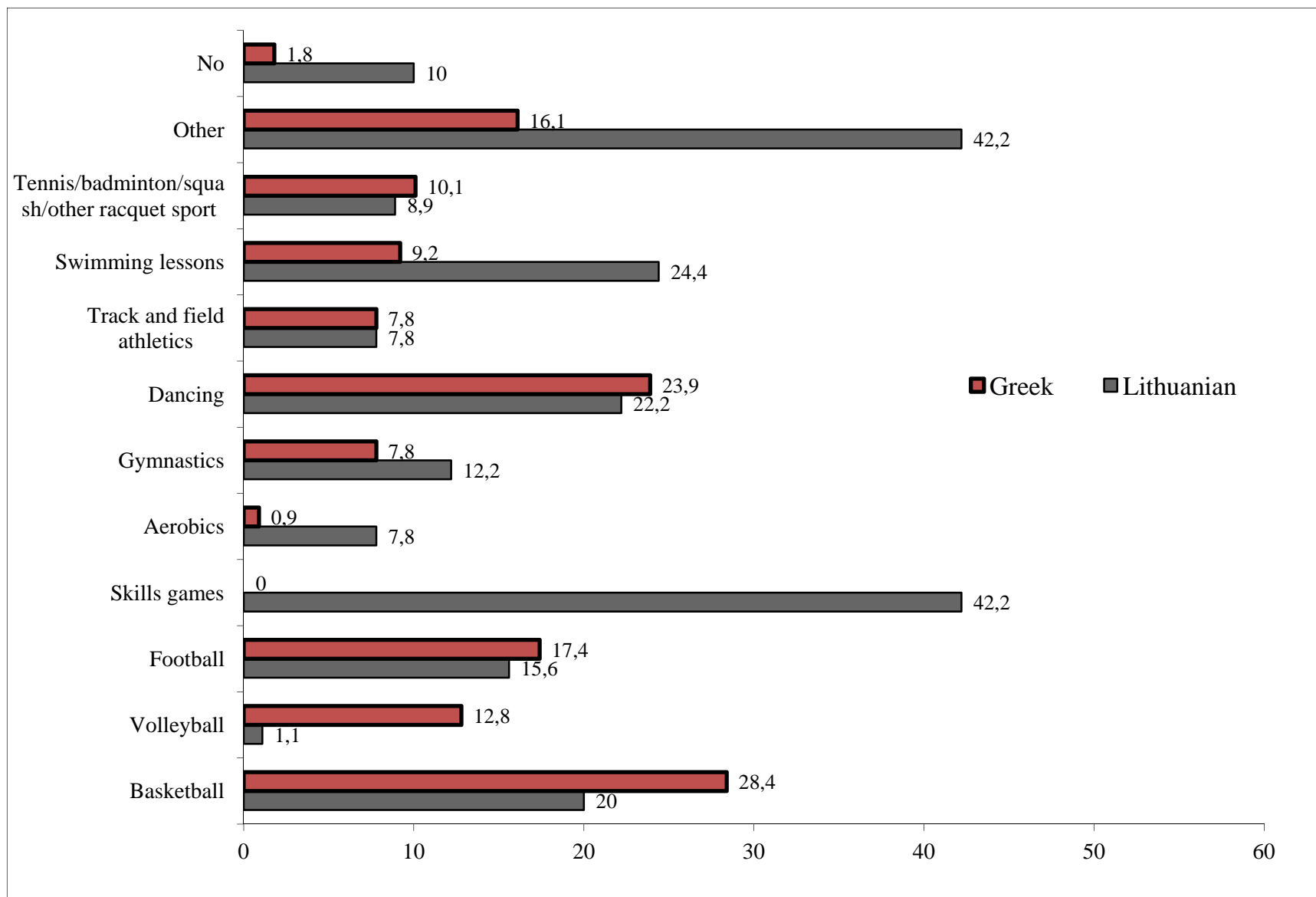

Organized physical activities of 1st – 2nd grade children in the past 7 days (%)



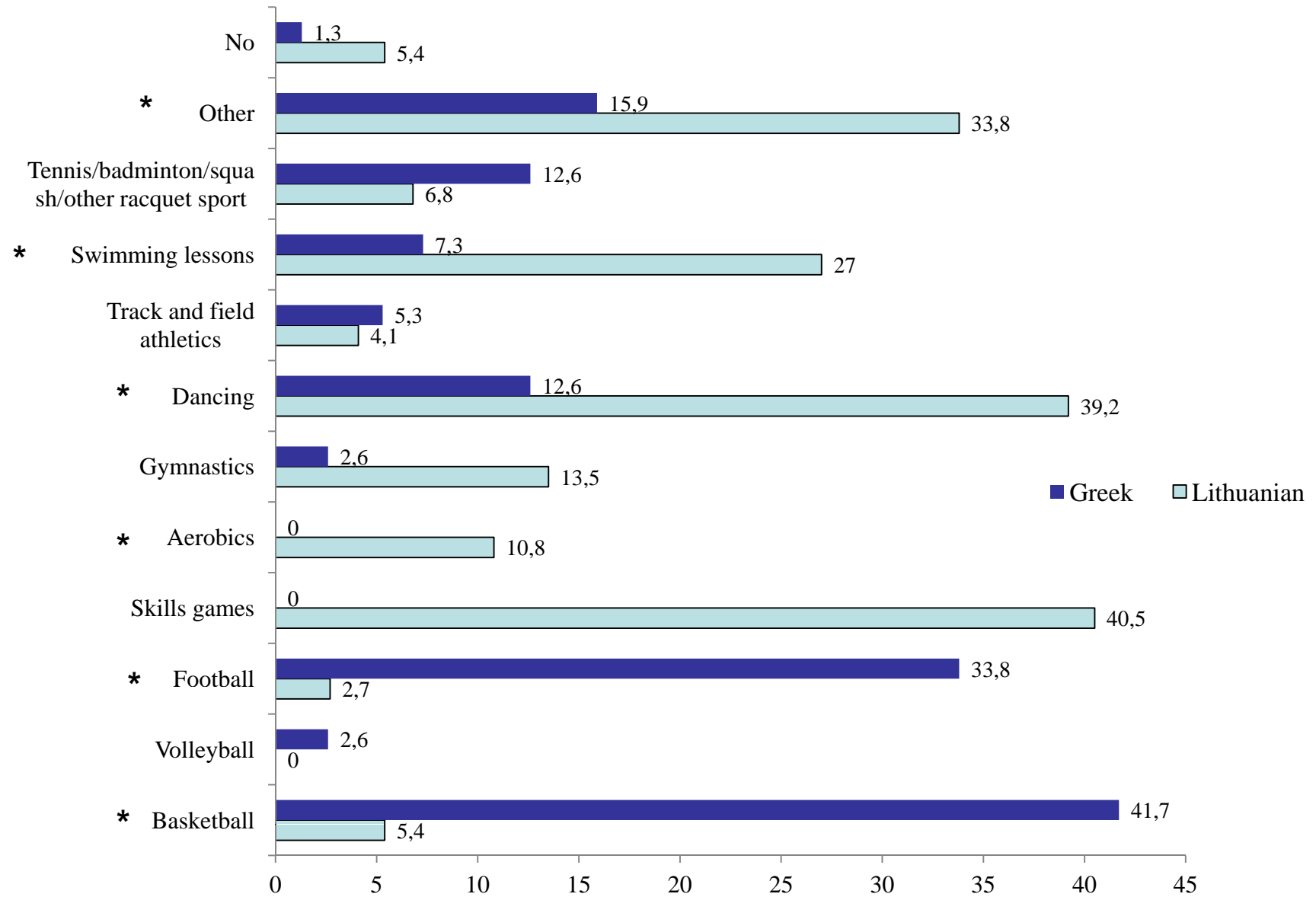

Organized physical activities of 3rd – 4th grade children in the past 7 days (%)



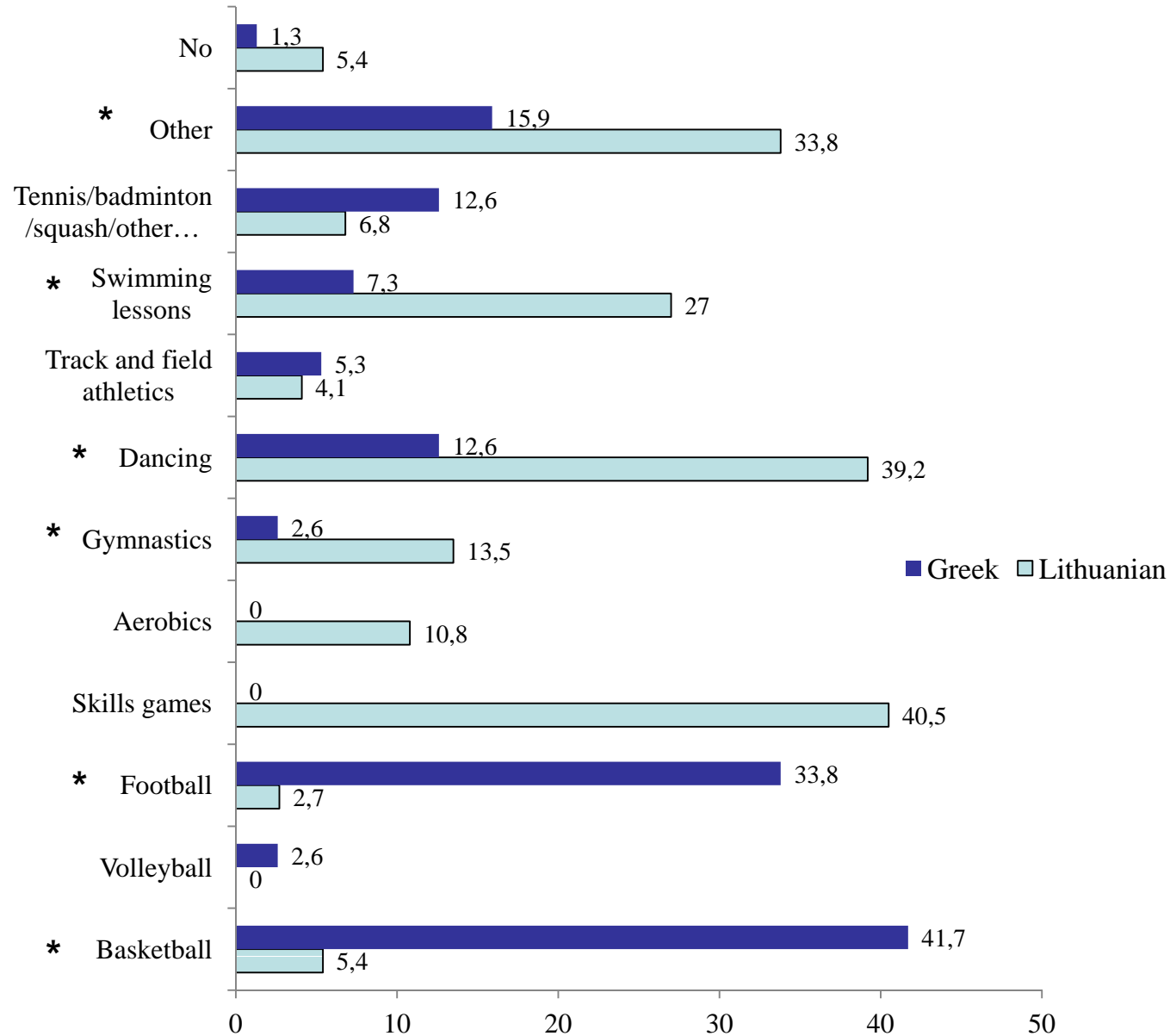

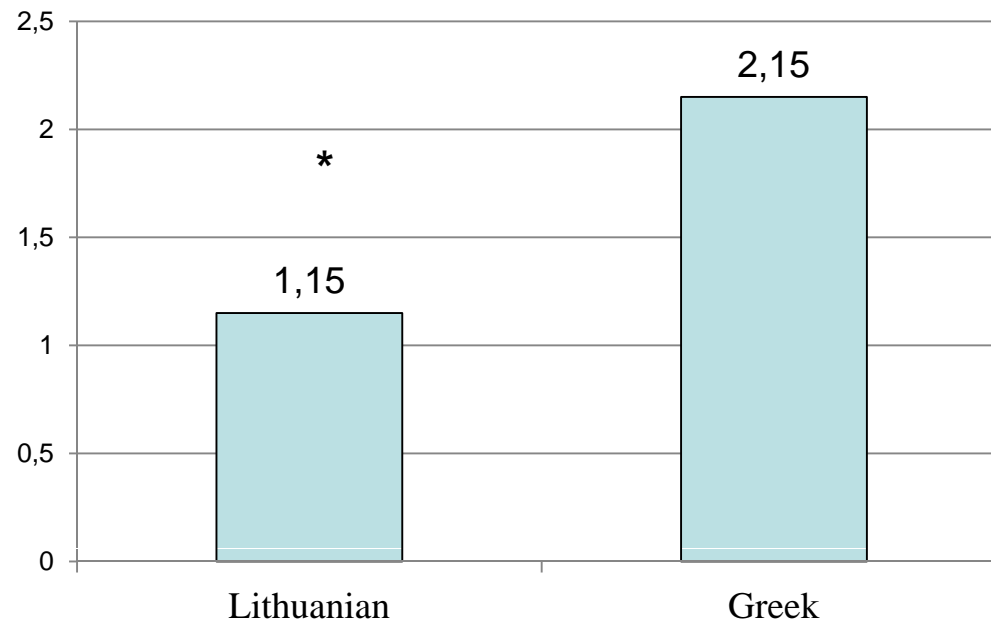
Organized physical activities of **boys** in the past 7 days (%)

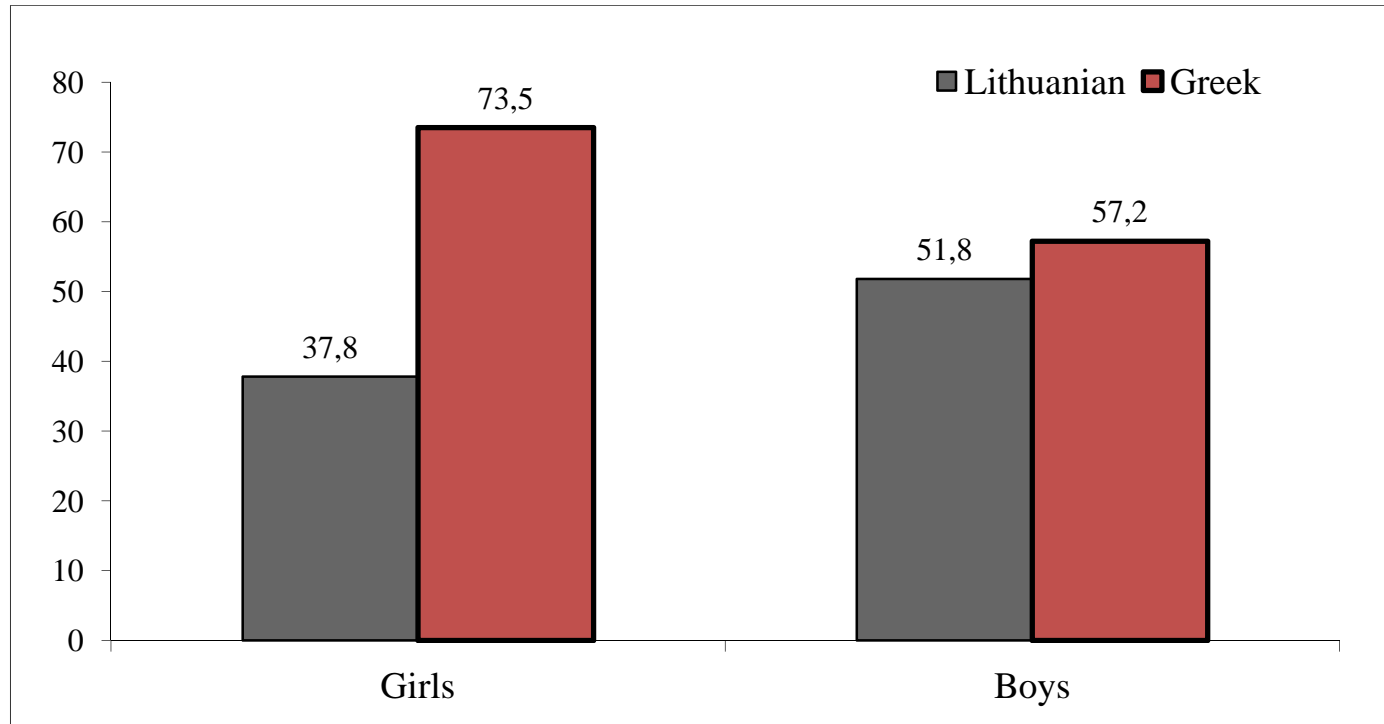
How much time children spend in organized physical activities?

- Children with organized physical activity longer than 1 hour were assigned to physically active group.



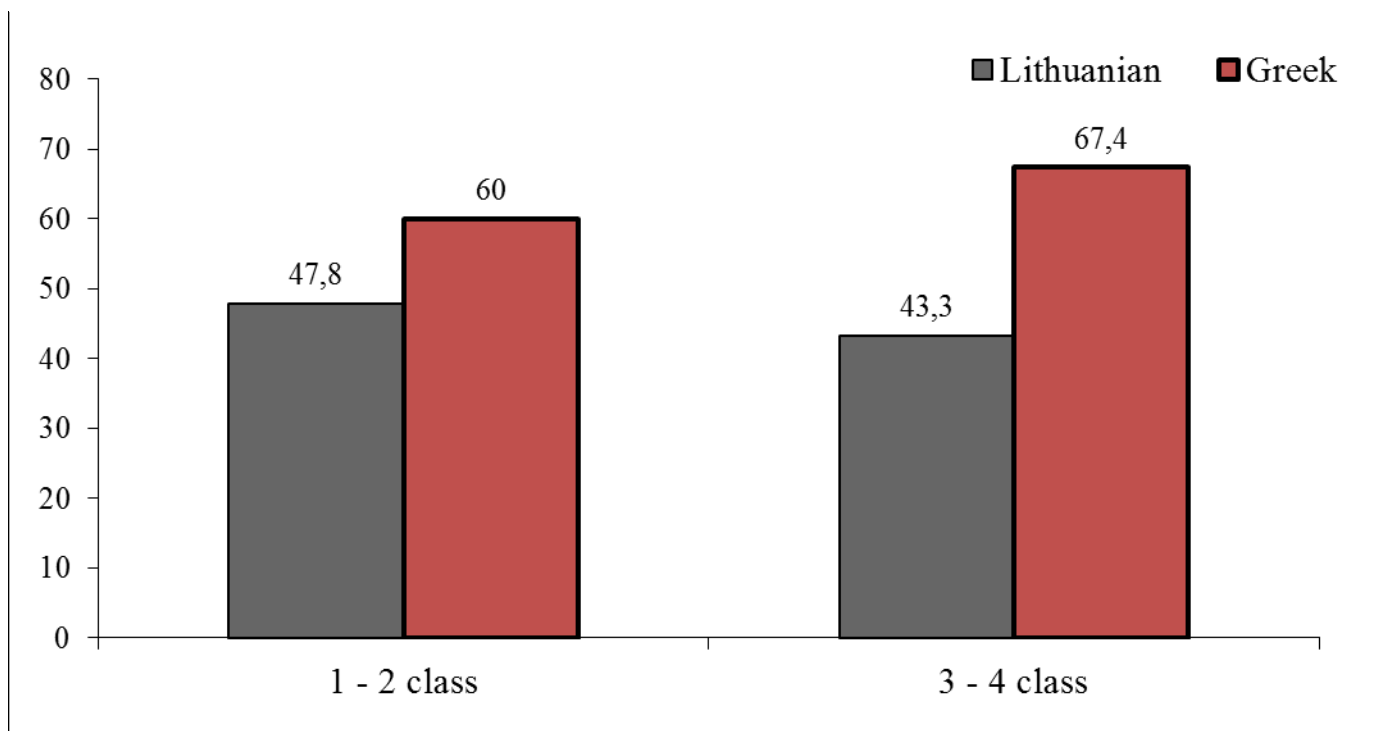

Lithuanian and Greek physically active children by gender (%)



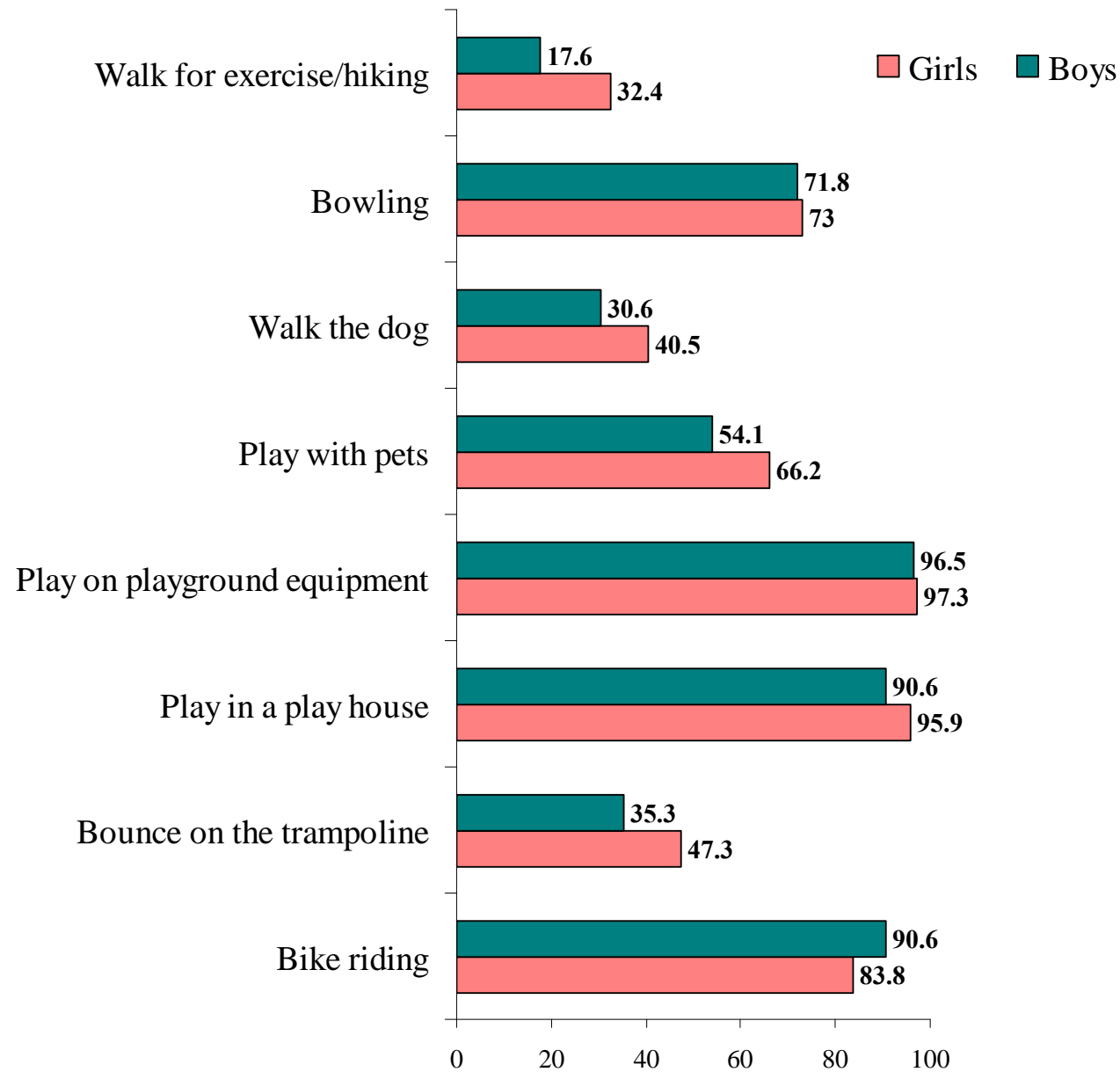

Lithuanian and Greek physically active children by classes (%)

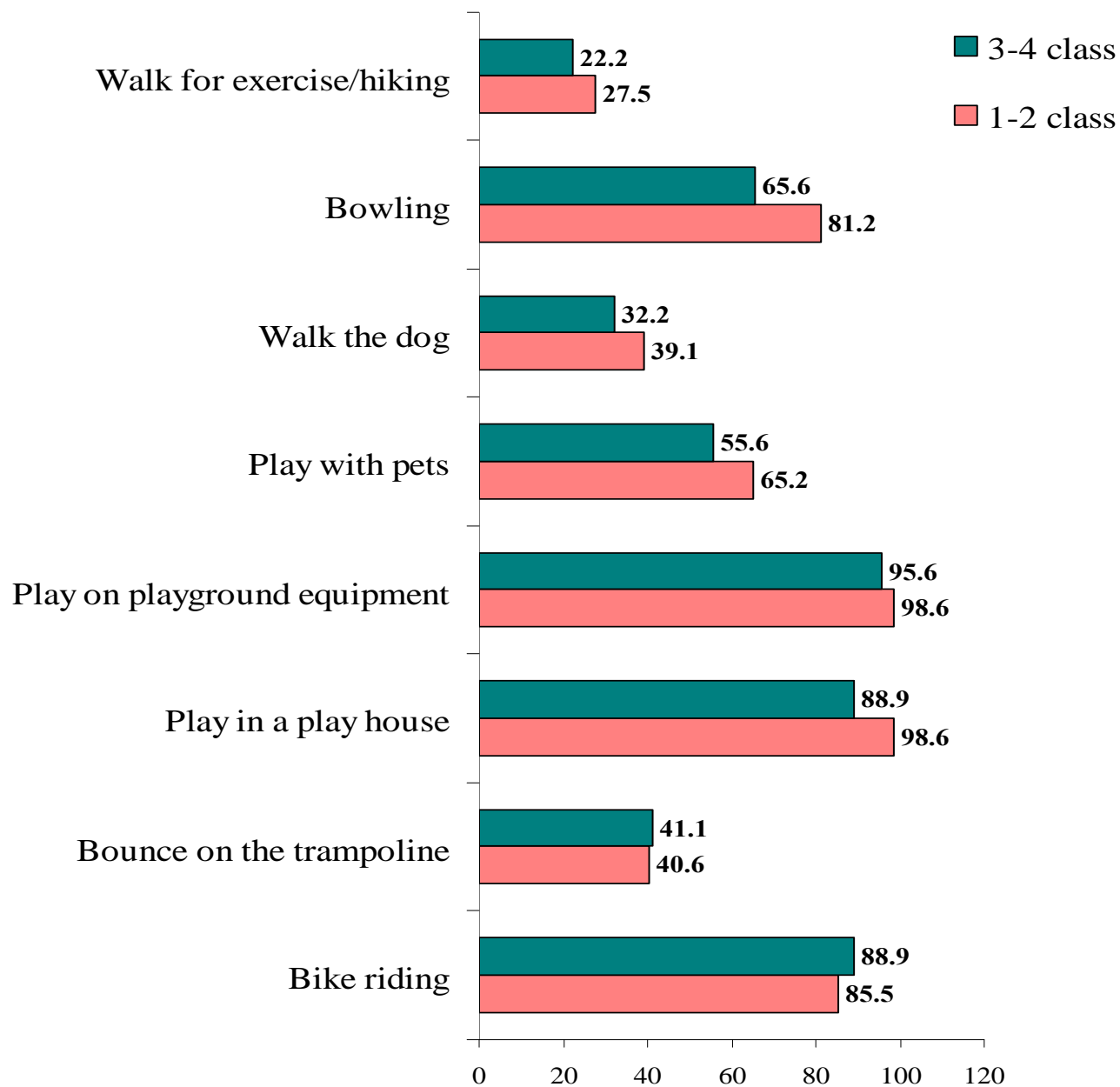

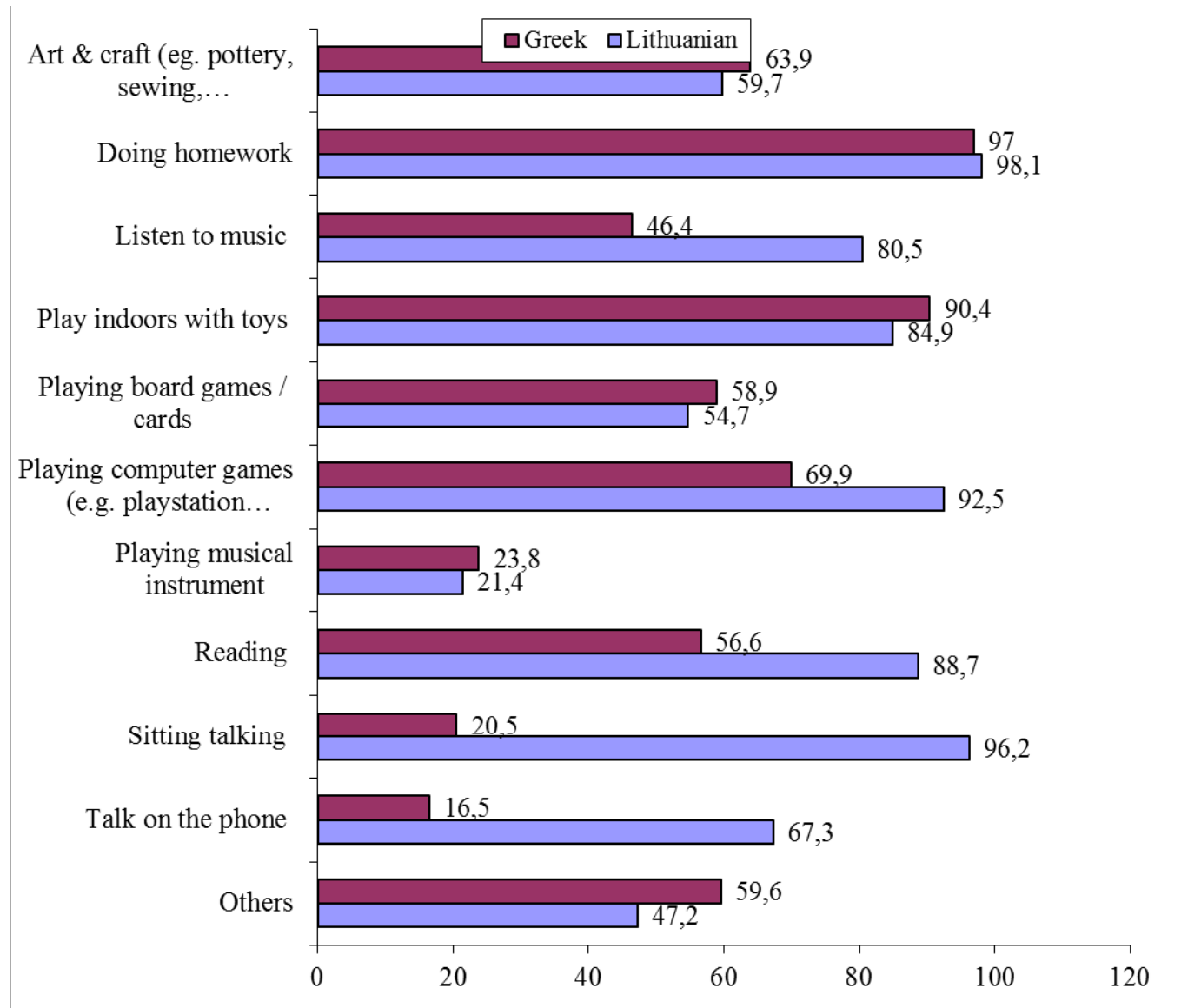
Physical activities in which Lithuanian children are engaged in leisure by gender (%)



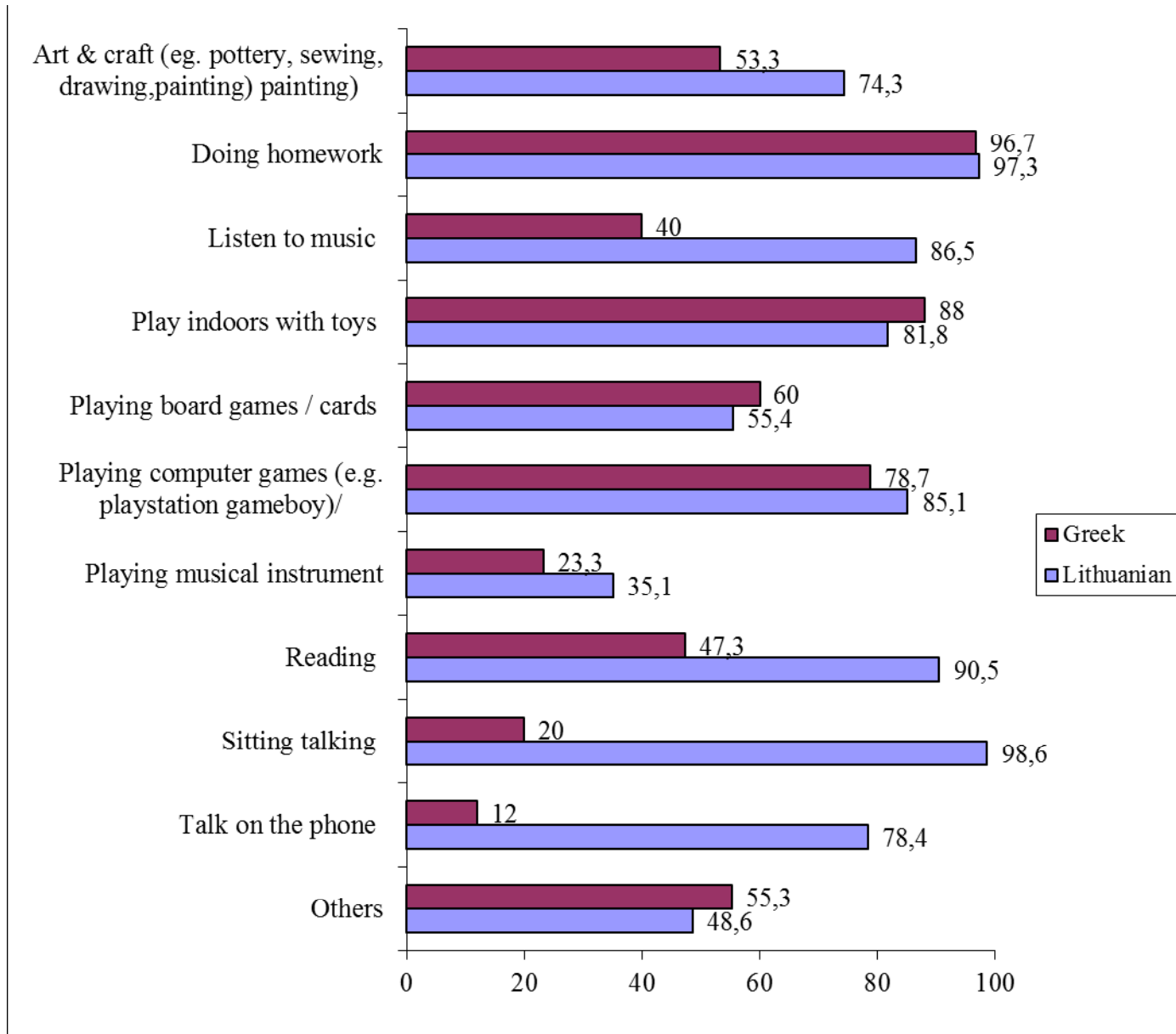
Physical activities in which Lithuanian children are engaged in leisure by classes (%)



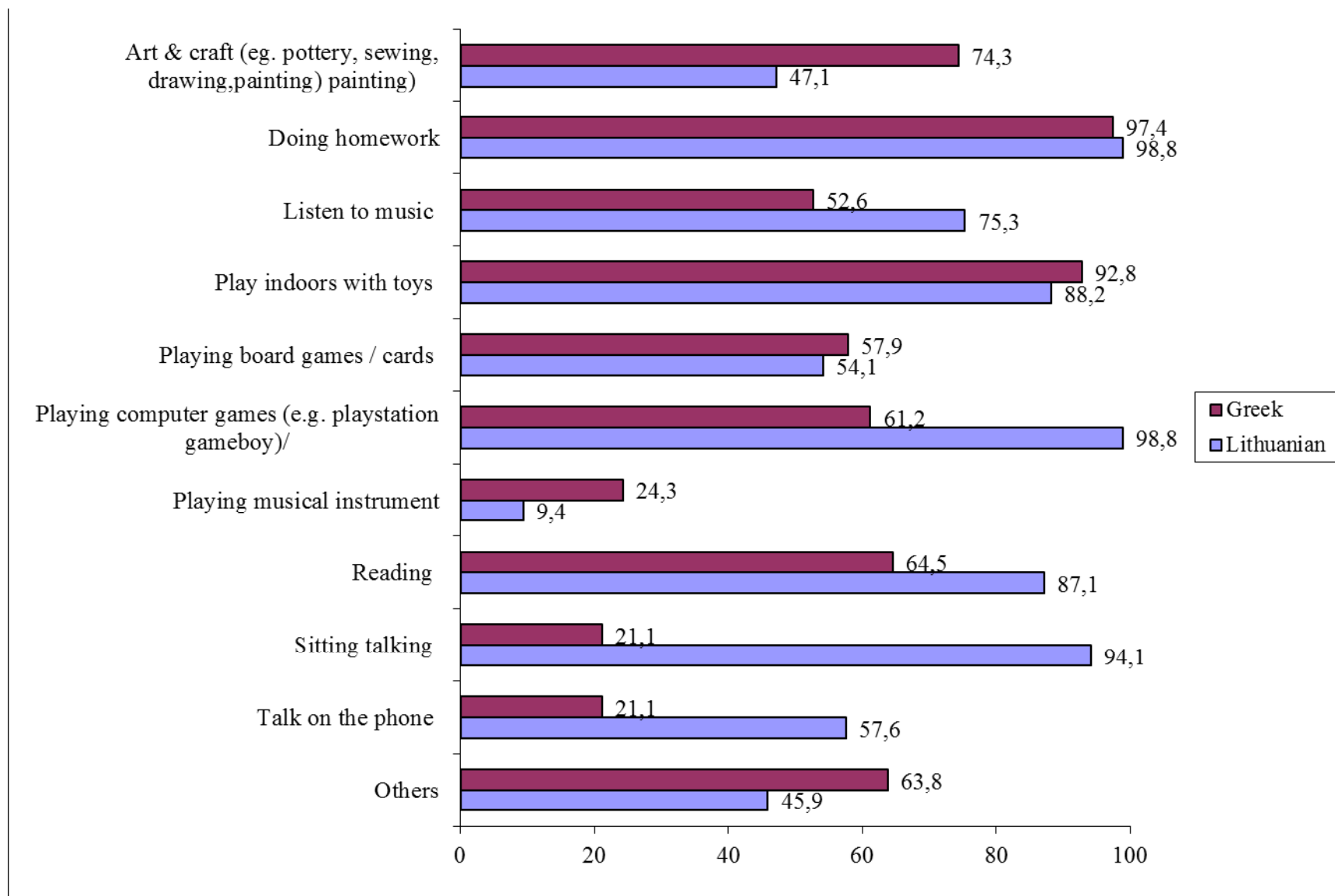
Sedentary leisure activities within seven days (%)



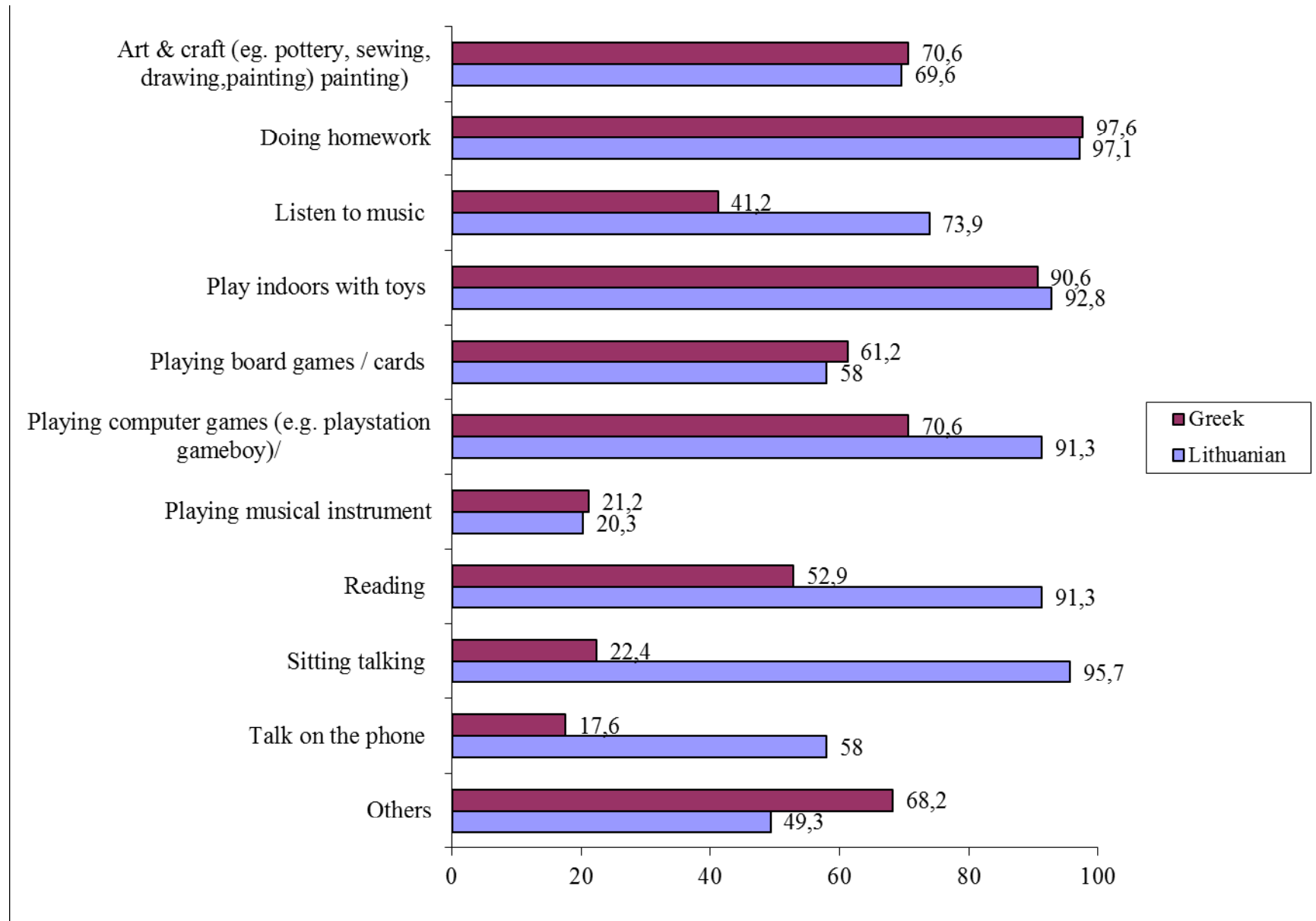
Sedentary leisure activities of girls within seven days (%)



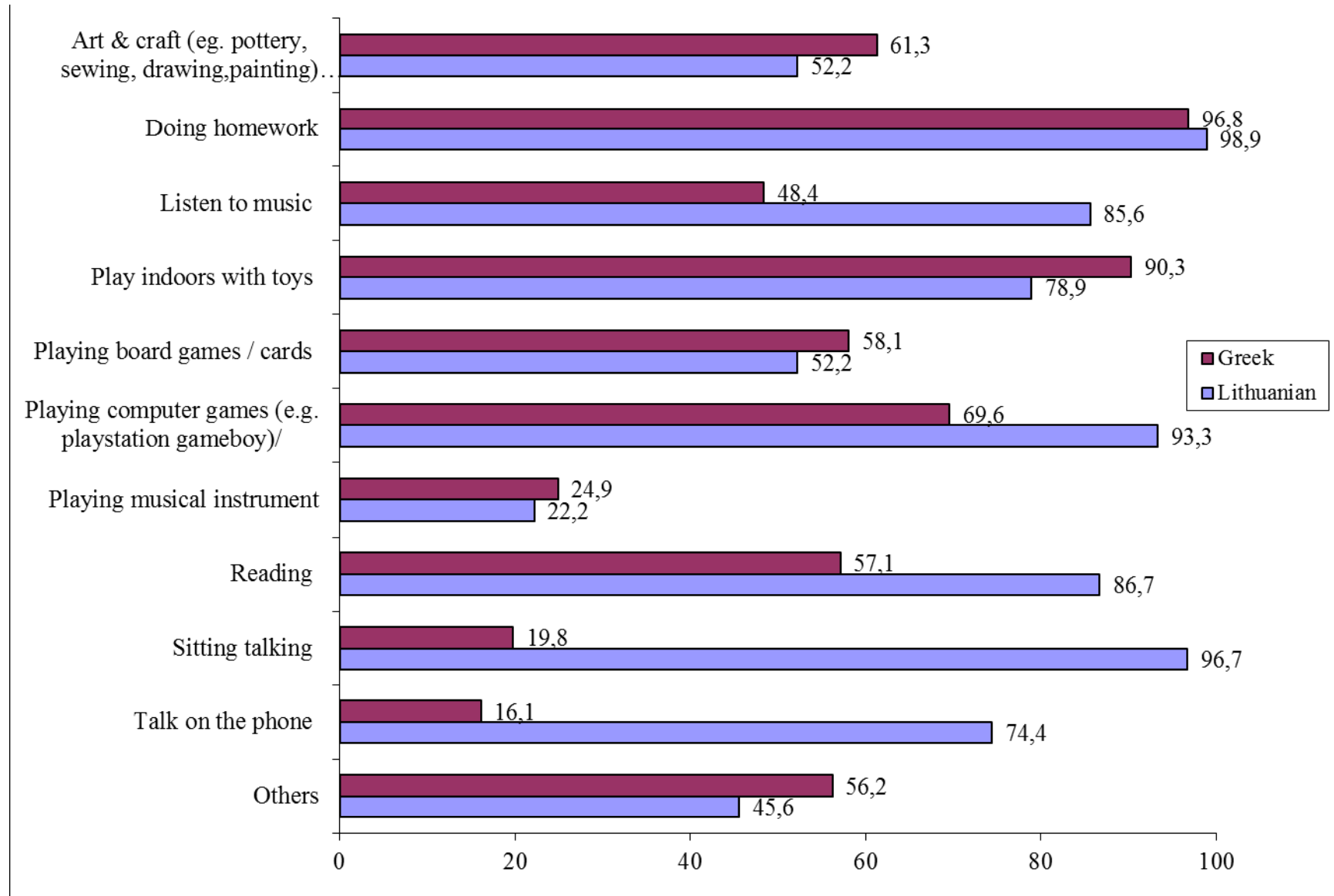
Sedentary leisure activities of boys within seven days (%)



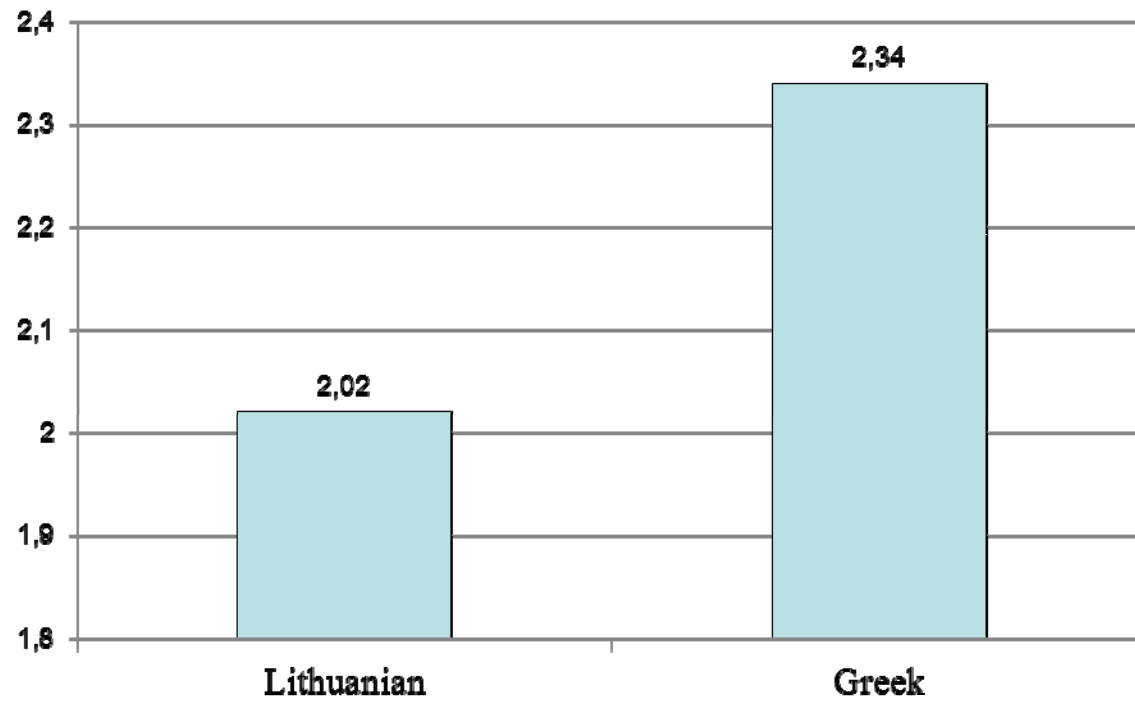
Sedentary leisure activities of 1 – 2 class children within seven days (%)



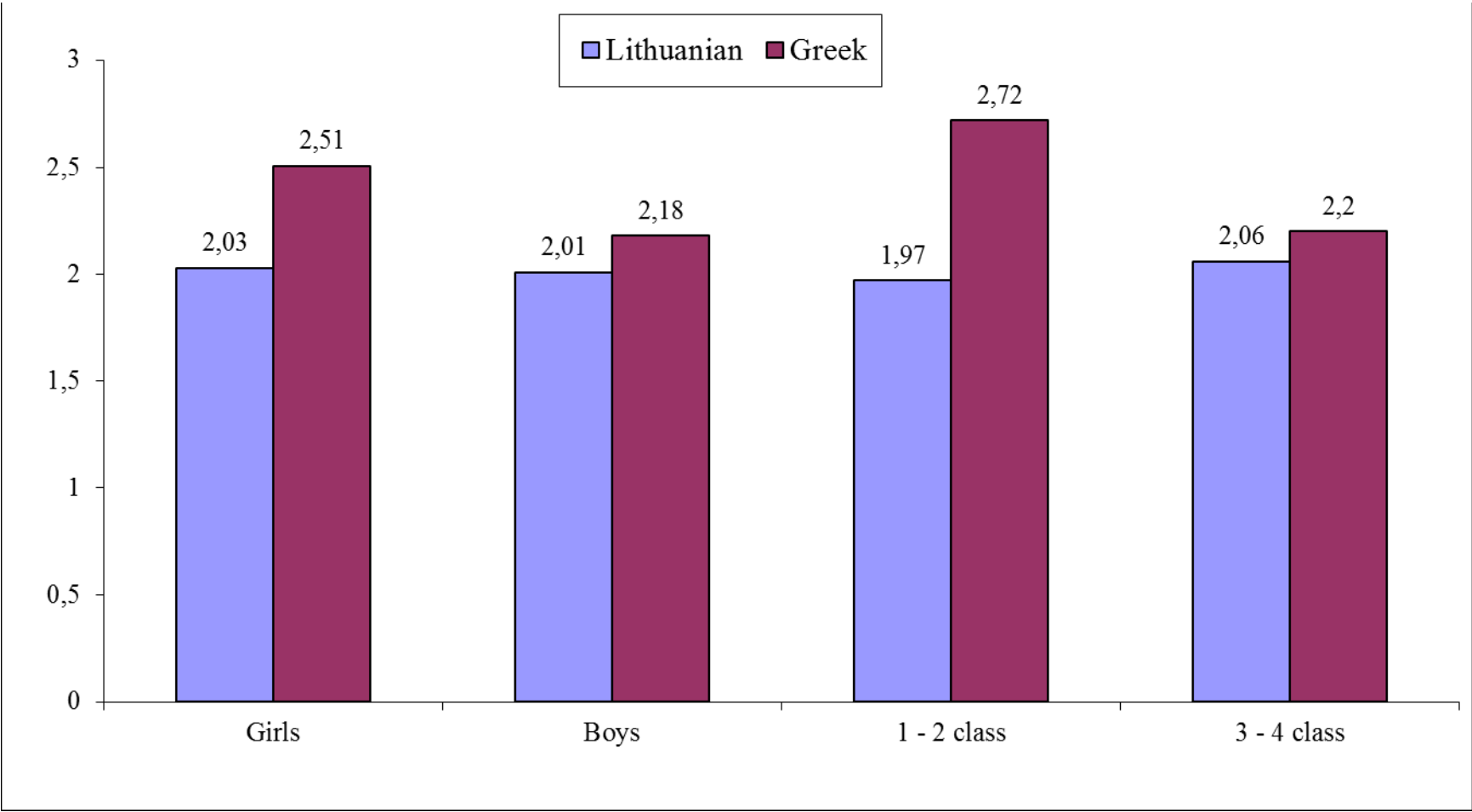
Sedentary leisure activities of 3 – 4 class children within seven days (%)



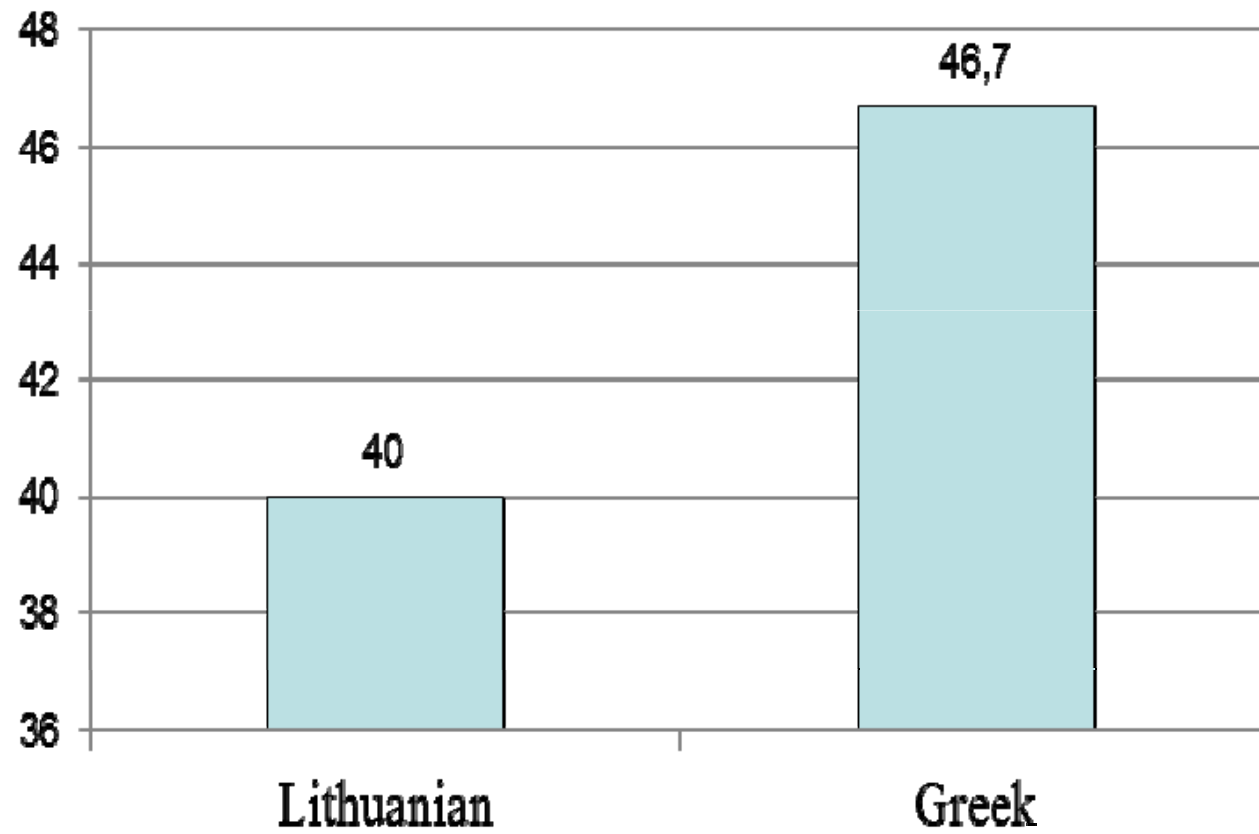
Children's weekly attended physical education lessons on average



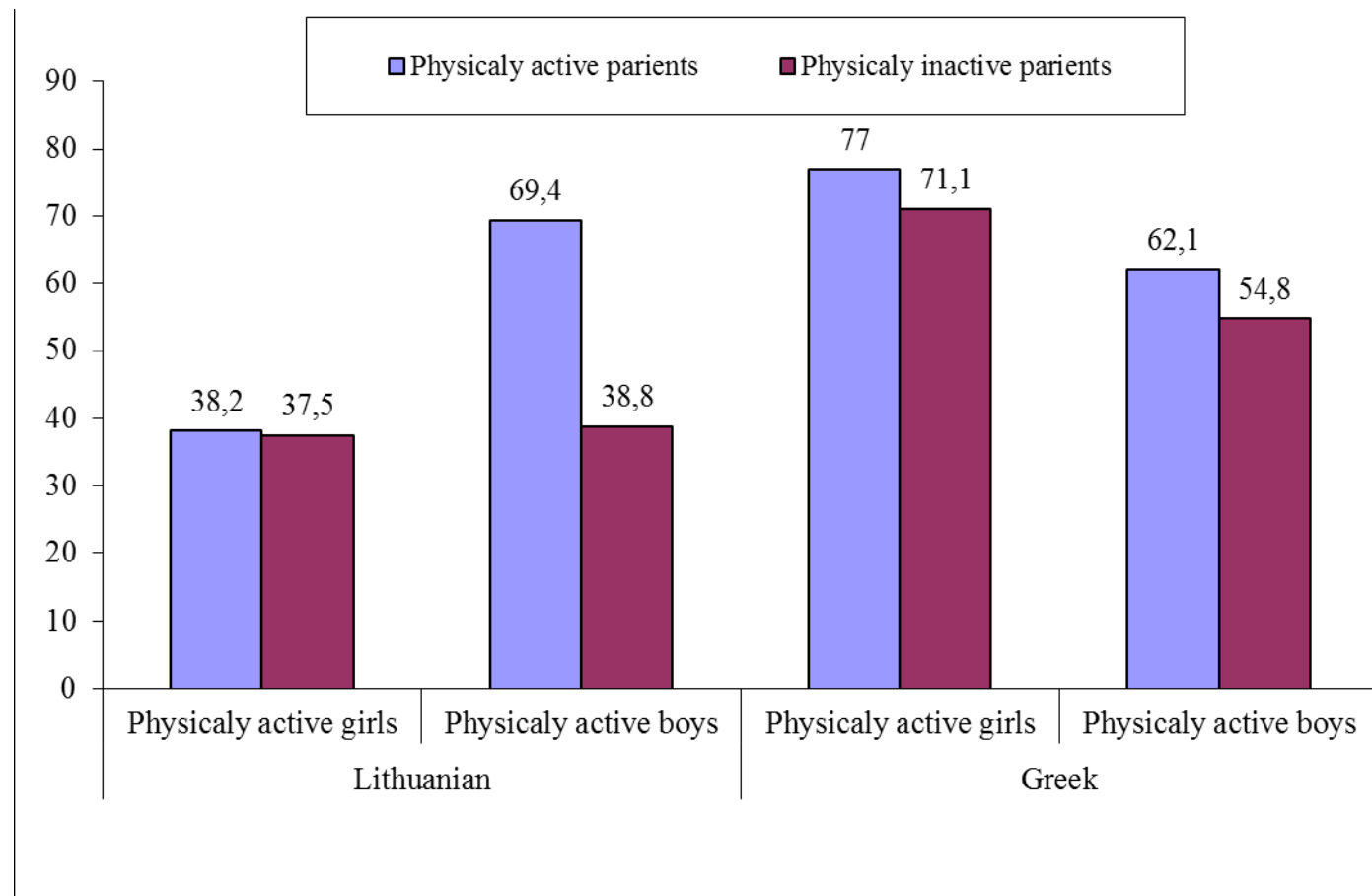
Children's weekly attended physical education lessons on average by gender and classes



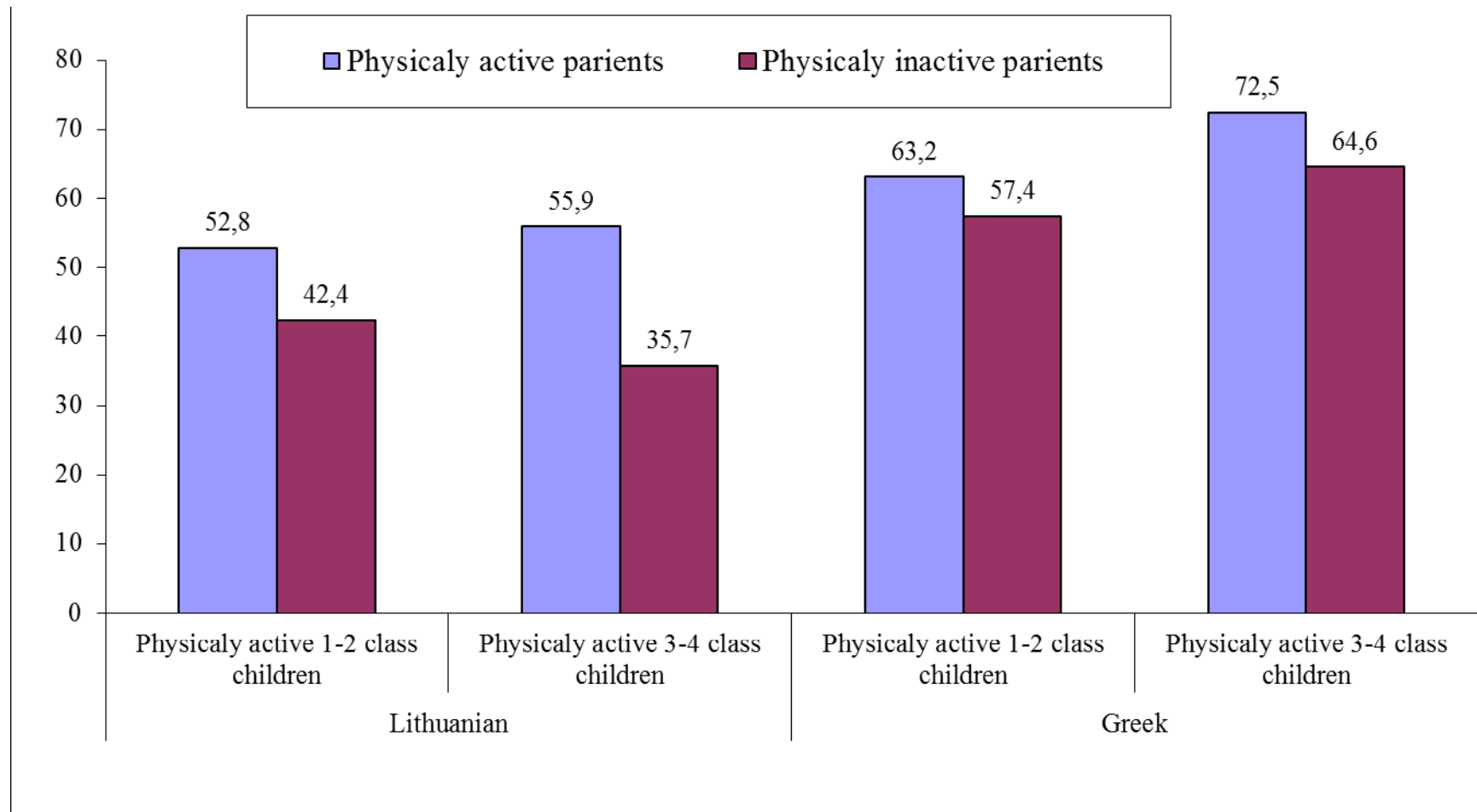
Parental physical activity (%)



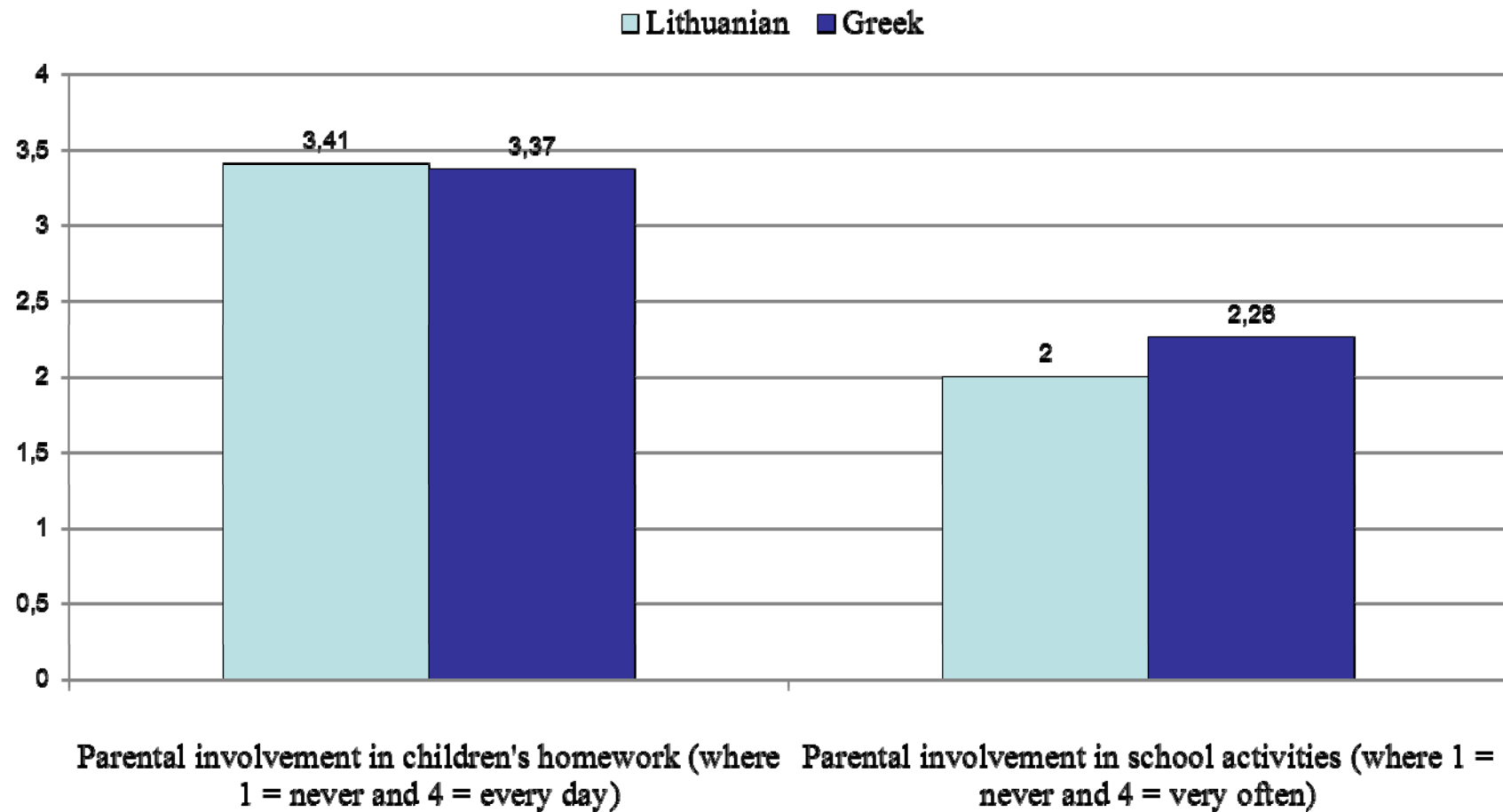
Distribution of children in sport according to physical activity of parental groups by gender (%)



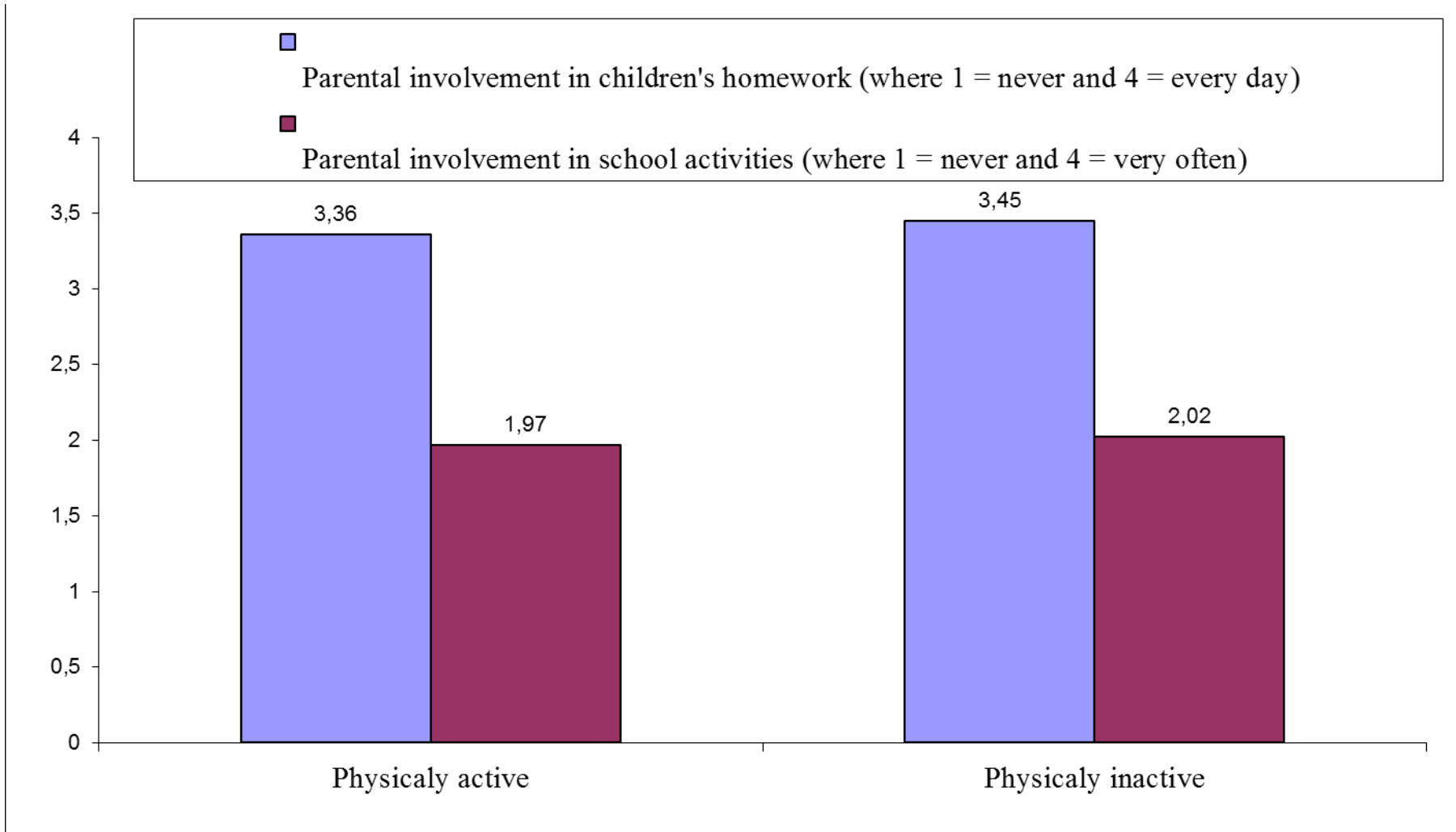
Distribution of children in sport according to physical activity of parental groups by classes (%)



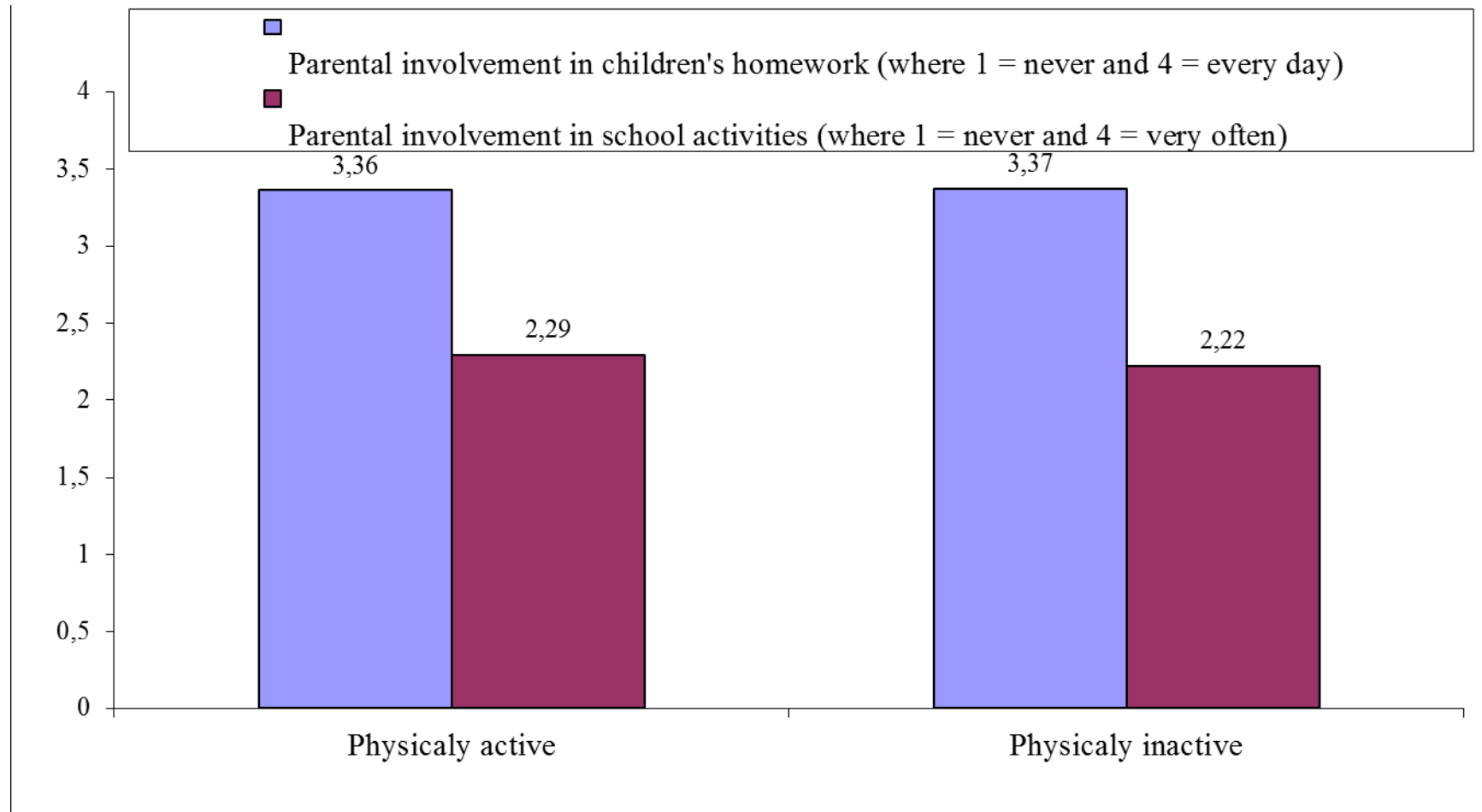
Parental support to children and school (average scores)



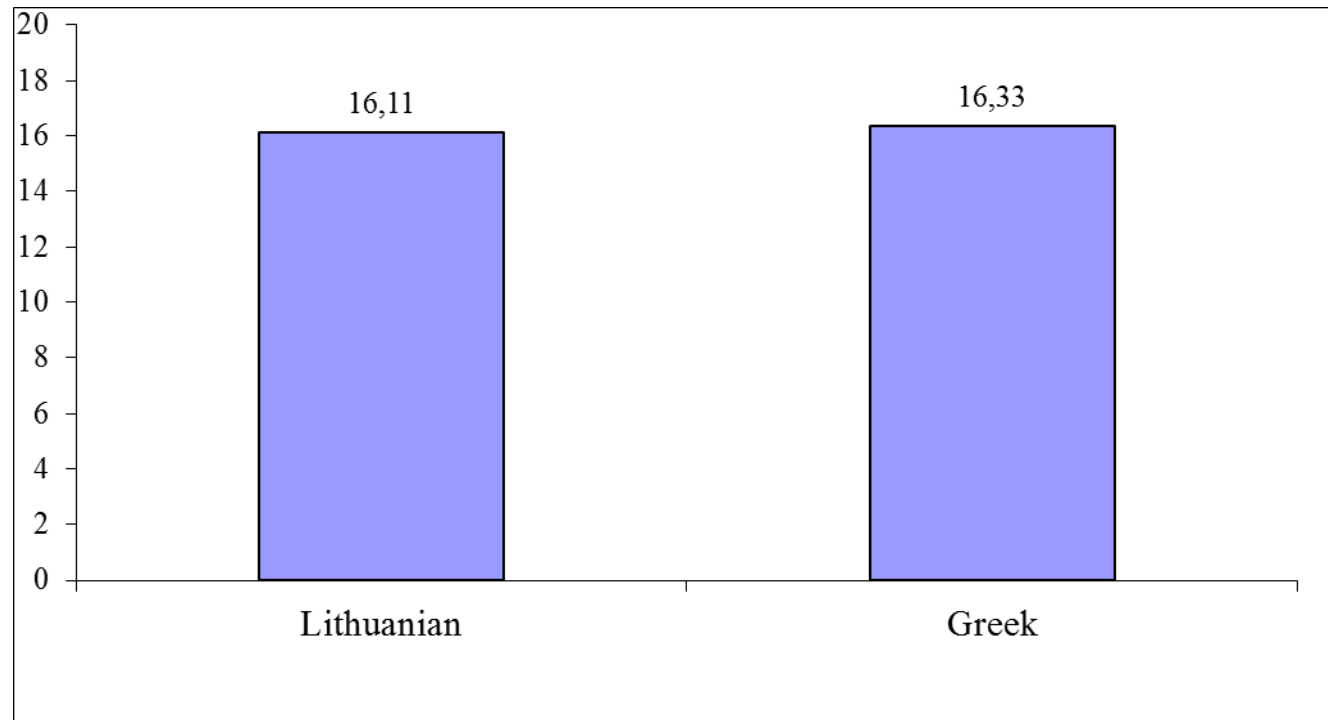
Lithuanian parental support to children and school by their physical activity (average scores)



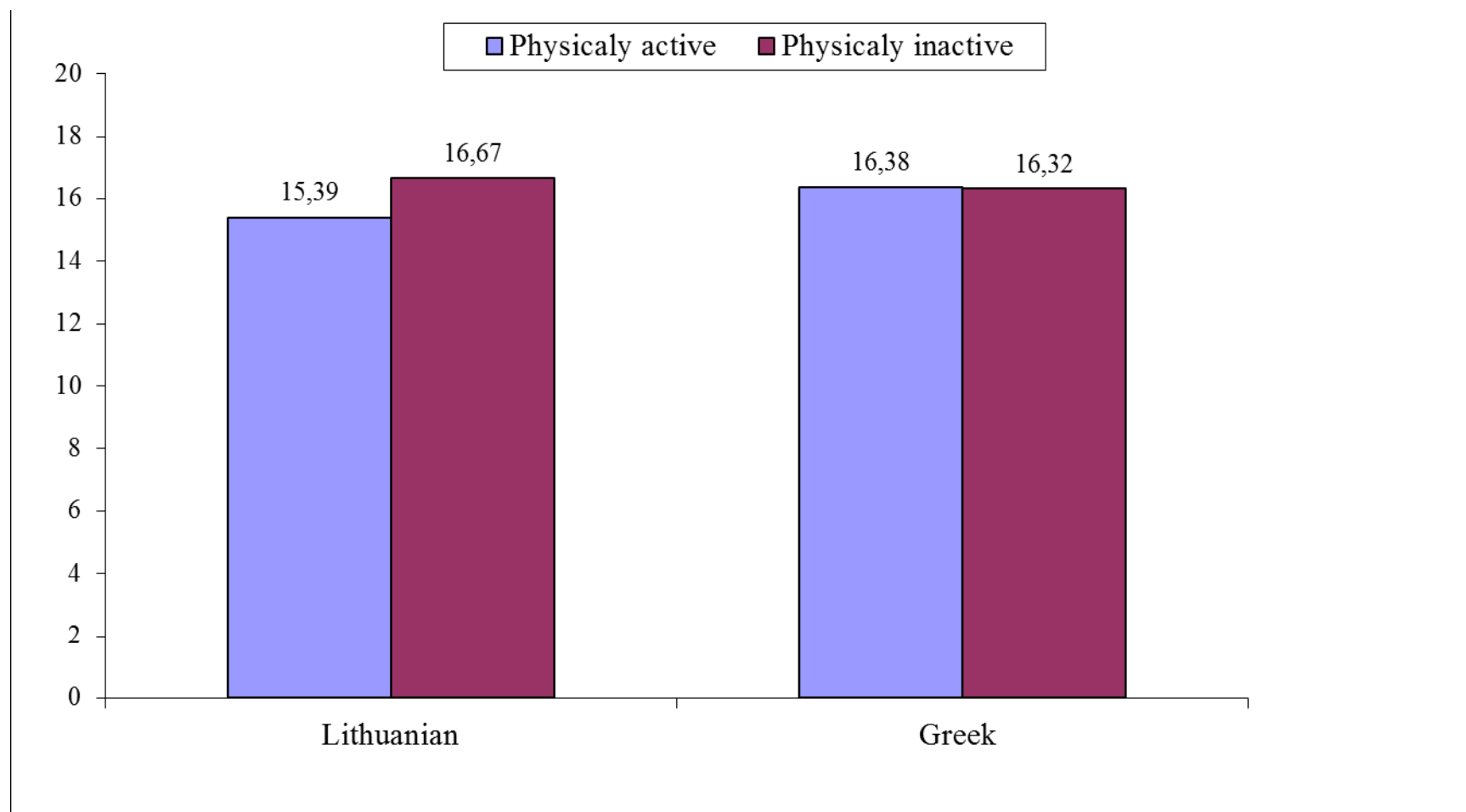
Greek parental support to children and school by their physical activity (average scores)



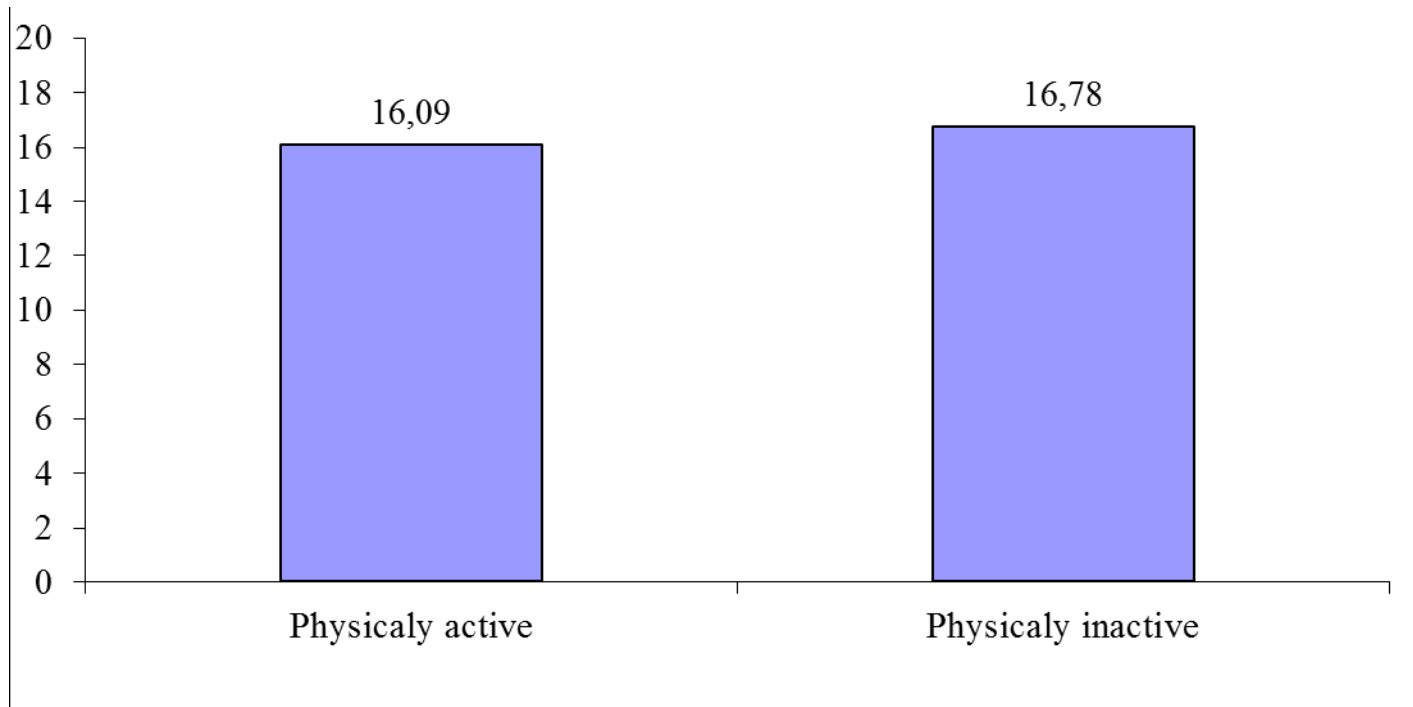
Children's sociability. *Note: higher scores indicate higher children's sociability.*



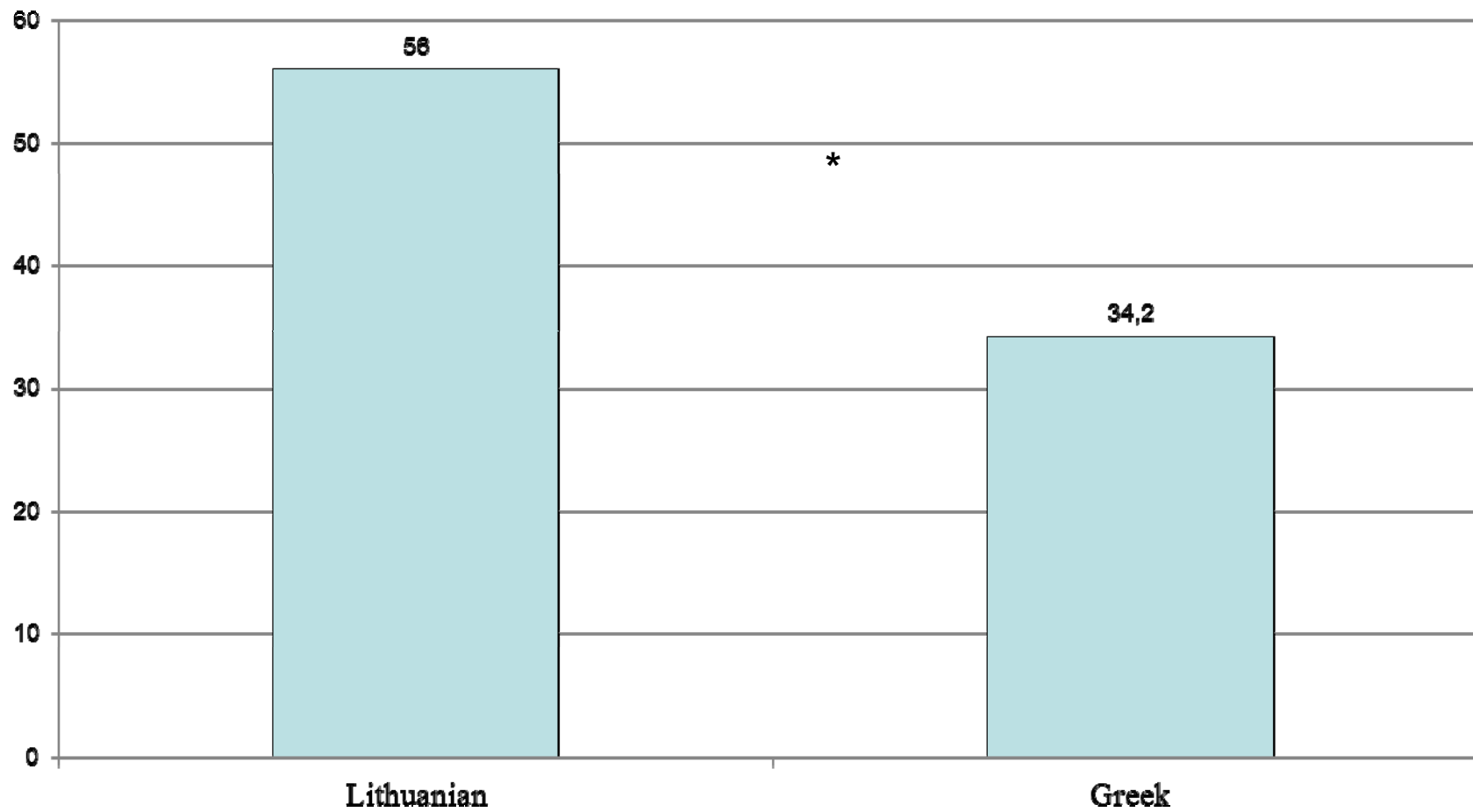
Children's sociability according to physical activity of parents



Children's sociability according to children's physical activity *Note: higher scores indicate higher children's sociability.*

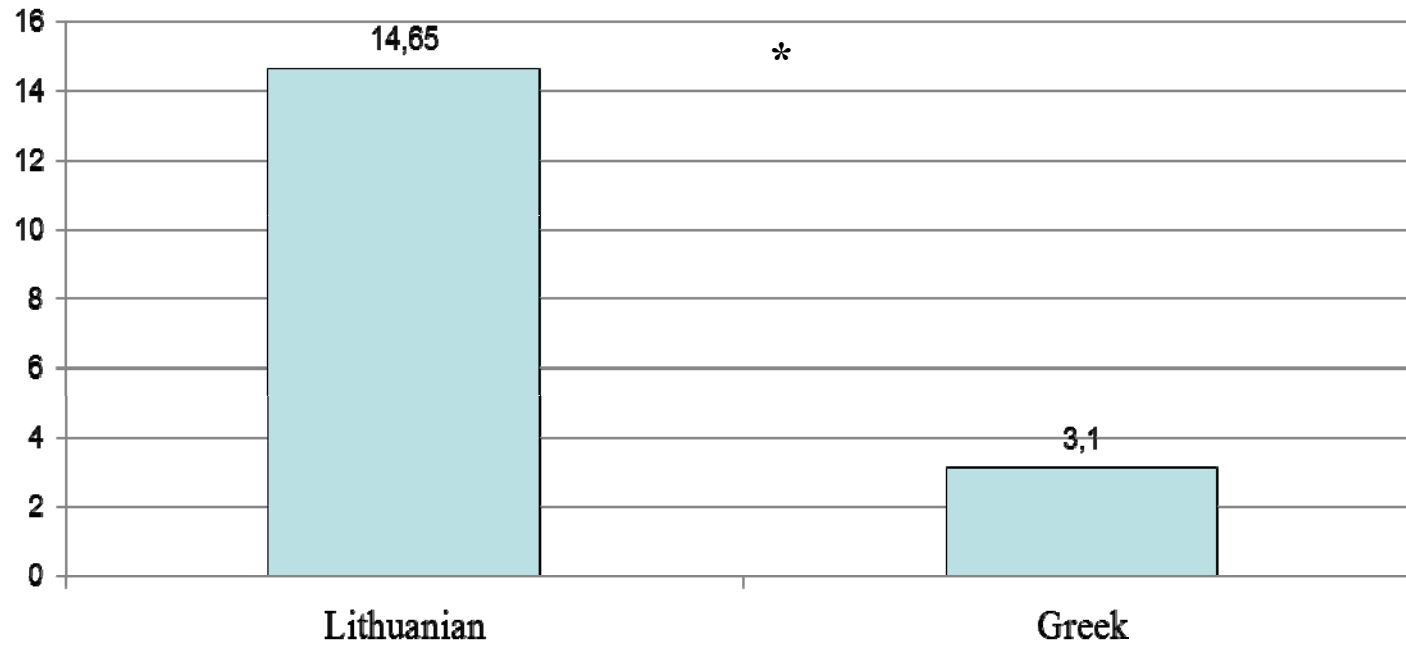


How many children walk to school?
